A Dutch Fisherman, Holland

Painted by Mortimer Menpes

David Roche Gallery is grateful to Caroline Webber for her generous donation of *A Dutch Fisherman*, *Holland*, painted by renowned South Australian artist Mortimer Menpes.

Menpes was born in Port Adelaide in 1855, the second son of property developer James Menpes and his wife Ann. After initial studies at the Adelaide School of Art, Mortimer migrated to England with his family in 1875 and took up further studies at the School of Art in London. A few years later, Menpes met American artist James McNeill Whistler; their subsequent friendship had a profound influence on Menpes' approach to composition and the development of his artistic vision. Menpes's inveterate travelling led him to places as far afield as Myanmar and Mexico. His 1900 visit to the Dutch community of Volendam provided him with everything to create this

detailed portrayal of a man dressed in the traditional garments worn by fishermen of the region. Menpes considered this work so highly that he selected it to illustrate the colour frontispiece for the second English edition of *World Pictures: A Record in Colour*, published in 1903.

This striking work by a significant British-Australian artist is currently on display in the Chinoiserie Bedroom of Fermoy House. David Roche Gallery acknowledge the Australian Government's Cultural Gifts Program's support of this gift.
